REA VAYA PHASE 1C (a) SERVICES START OPERATING ON MONDAY 1 DECEMBER 2025

The City of Joburg's Rea Vaya Bus Rapid Transport (BRT) Phase 1C (a) will start operating on Monday 1 December 2025. Extensive operational readiness checks have now been completed for buses to start operating along Phase 1C (a).

This is a new route that will bring safe, affordable and reliable transport to the residents of Berea, Yeoville, Orange Groove, Cheldonale, Norwood, Balfour Park, Bramley, Wynberg, Alexandra, Marlboro, Athol, Sandton, Sandown, Longmeadow and Greenstone.

Passengers are advised to obtain and load their travel cards at the selected Rea Vaya Phase 1C (a), 1A and 1B stations from 05h00-21h00

The service was launched by the City of Joburg Executive Mayor, Councillor (Cllr) Dada Morero and MMC for Transport Cllr Kenny Kunene on 23 October 2025.
